ACTION STEPS: YOUR PATH TO FREEDOM

The Vision:

Victory Podcast was created to go beyond polished sermons and Sunday messages—to reveal the deeply personal stories of how God's Word transforms everyday life. It's designed to feel like sitting at a kitchen table, connecting heart to heart.

The Purpose:

- Share practical faith applications for daily lifeMake life and ministry simple through real stories of breakthrough
- Help believers walk in victory through everyday challenges

Living Everyday Life Through a Faith Lens

Listeners worldwide have tuned in, feeling inspired, full of hope, and equipped with practical tools to apply in their daily walk. The podcast has made ministry feel accessible and victory feel attainable.



Throughout 2025, certain moments stood out—not because of eloquent words, but because of the raw anointing and truth that broke through. These lessons have the power to shift how you approach faith, ministry, family, and breakthrough.

1. Ministry Flows From Relationship, Not the Other Way Around

Guest: Dr. Luc Niebergall (Ep.11)

"We forget that Judas cast out demons. Judas preached the gospel. But he was disconnected from the heart of Jesus. Ministry is not a relationship with God. The more ministry you do doesn't make you closer to God. Ministry is the overflow of intimacy with Him."

Key Teaching:

Your relationship with the Father is the priority, not your ministry output. Judas performed miracles but betrayed Jesus because he was disconnected from His heart. When you connect to God's heart first, ministry becomes a natural overflow of who you are in Him.



Angel's Reflection:

"I don't think I cried in any other podcast, but that one. I was legitimately crying as he was sharing a story about a woman being healed. The anointing was on him. It came straight out of the Father's heart."

This episode was recorded in Edmonton during the Timothy Conference at Dr. Luc's personal studio. Angel described the anointing in that room as palpable—it wasn't just storytelling, it was the Father's heart flowing through. "Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed."



2. Dreaming With God: Breaking Out of the Box

Reflection: Leah (Ep.07)

When asked what stretched her faith the most this year, Leah shared that it was learning to dream with God—refusing to let circumstances or her own mind put limitations on what God can do.

"Sometimes our own minds and circumstances kind of put us in a box. When the truth is that God is not in the box. He is a God that can do anything. And there is nothing impossible for Him."

Leah's Declaration:

"He is my source. He is my provider. My strength. He is my everything. He is my well. And that is where I am to draw. And that is who I am to partner with. And that is who is going to walk with me."

The Promise:

"When you do, you can walk in victory. You can have faith for any situation in any circumstance, no matter what you walk through. He's right beside you. You can get through anything. You can go anywhere. You can evangelize. You can preach the gospel. You can have faith for those big things."

3. Introduce Kids to Jesus First, Ministry Second

Guest: Pastor Joel Huizing (Ep.12)

Key Teaching:

Focus on helping children develop their own personal relationship with Jesus before expecting them to serve in ministry. Connection to Jesus must come before service for Jesus. When kids know Him personally, ministry becomes a natural expression of love, not a burden.

Angel's Response:

"I don't think I've heard this principle so simply stated—introduce your kids to Jesus first and have them develop a relationship with Jesus, and then ministry. I never thought that was a thing. Hearing it so plainly, it's so good hearing revelation when people have walked through things like this and they just share it freely. I think we can raise our family well."



4. God Is Your Source in Every Season

From: 'God is My Source' Episode (Ep.08)

Key Teaching:

God is not just A source—He is THE source of provision, breakthrough, and everything you need. This truth applies to finances, relationships, health, and every area of life.

Angel's Testimony:

When asked what stretched his faith the most this year, Angel shared: "The finances episode challenged my faith so much. I was able to hear from these other men—especially as a man, how finances and that kind of thing is mostly on a man to provide for family. Hearing the stories of how they went through situations, how they saw breakthrough, what they did—I felt like my faith was challenged in that moment to believe God for what is already ours."

This episode featured men and women sharing their testimonies of trusting God through financial challenges. Their stories proved that when you stand on God's Word and recognize Him as your source, breakthrough is inevitable.



What Stretched Their Faith in 2025

Angel:

The finances episode stretched Angel's faith the most—hearing testimonies from other men about provision and breakthrough challenged him to believe God for what is already his through Christ.

Leah:

Dreaming with God stretched Leah's faith the most—learning to break out of the box of circumstances and limitations, and recognizing God as her source, provider, strength, and everything. This revelation empowered her to have faith for any situation.



ACTION STEPS

Apply These Truths Today

- Prioritize intimacy over activity. Spend time with God today—not to get something from Him, but simply to connect with His heart. Ministry will flow naturally from this place.
- >>>> Break out of the box. Ask God what He wants to do in your life without limiting Him based on past experiences or current circumstances. Dream with Him.
- >>>> Declare: 'God is my source.' Speak this truth out loud over your finances, relationships, health, and future. Make it the foundation of your faith.
- For parents: Build relationship before ministry. Help your children develop their own connection with Jesus. Teach them to hear His voice and experience His love personally.
- >>>> Trust the process. The seeds you're planting today are growing. Keep believing for breakthrough, even when you can't see the fruit yet.



FAITH DECLARATIONS FOR 2026

- **1. Nothing is impossible with God.** He's not intimidated by your circumstances—He's bigger than all of them.
- **2. God walks beside you.** You are never alone in any trial or victory. His presence is your strength.
- **3. You can have faith for big things.** God has equipped you to believe for miracles, breakthrough, and transformation.
- **4. Your seeds are sprouting.** Every prayer, step of faith, and seed sown is producing fruit. Trust the process.
