KEY TEACHING #1

CHOOSE VICTORY, NOT VICTIMHOOD

"We are born again. We are born of the greatest victory. Being a victim does not work. You can't be in victory and walk as a victim. You got to pick one."

The Core Truth:

- Christians are born of the greatest victory—Christ's resurrection
- We are seated with Christ in heavenly places in a place of authority
- Today's culture celebrates victimhood—the opposite of Christianity
- Victory and victimhood cannot coexist—you must choose one

Action Steps:

- Start each day declaring: *"I am born of victory. I choose to walk as an overcomer today."*
- When challenges arise, ask yourself: *"Am I responding as a victim or from a place of authority in Christ?"*
- Reject victim language in your speech. Replace *"This always happens to me"* with *"I have authority over this situation."*



KEY TEACHING #2

STAY UNOFFENDED AT ALL COSTS

“You really have to stay out of anger and offence. Keep a heart that is open to the Lord and open to others. You have to do it five, six, seven times a day for the same situation—choose the Word, choose to walk in love.”

The Core Truth:

- Offense is a choice, not an automatic response
- Pride makes you vulnerable to offense—humility protects you
- Staying unoffended requires constant, conscious decisions throughout the day
- “Great peace have they which love thy law” (Psalm 119:165)

The Example: The Canaanite Woman (Matthew 15)

When seeking healing for her daughter, she faced three opportunities for offense:

- Jesus didn’t answer her at all
- Jesus said He wasn’t sent to her people
- Jesus used what was essentially a racial slur, calling her a dog



Instead of taking offense, she responded with humility:
"Okay, if you want me to be a dog, I'll be a dog. Even dogs get the crumbs under the table."

Result: Jesus said, *"Woman, great is your faith! Be it done to you as you desire."* Her daughter was healed instantly.

ACTION STEPS:

- When hurt or disappointed, immediately choose to forgive—before the feeling sets in
- Keep a short account. Don't let offense accumulate over days or weeks
- Practice humility daily: *"Lord, You are the head. I will follow You."*
- Remember: You can't be offended unless you're in pride. When tempted to be offended, check your heart for pride



KEY TEACHING #3

MAKE A QUALITY DECISION FOR THE LONG HAUL

"You really have to make a quality decision. I'm in this for the long haul. You have to know God's called you. Then you say, 'Lord, you are the head of this church. I will follow you and do as you say.' That's the first dedication."

The Core Truth:

- »»» Ministry, marriage, and calling require settled commitment, not emotional decision-making
- »»» You must know you're called before you can endure the inevitable challenges
- »»» Challenges will come: people will leave, get angry, criticize you
- »»» When your commitment is to Christ (not circumstances), you can weather any storm

ACTION STEPS:

- »»» Write down your calling and commitment. Make it specific and dated
- »»» When challenges arise, return to your written commitment—not your feelings
- »»» Regularly declare: *"Lord, You are the head. I'm following You, not building my own kingdom."*



KEY TEACHING #4

INTRODUCE YOUR KIDS TO JESUS BEFORE MINISTRY

"Introduce your kids to Jesus before you introduce them to ministry."

—Joel Huizing

The Core Truth:

- Children in ministry families can know religious activity without knowing Jesus personally
- Your first place of ministry is your home—the people you see every day
- Minister to your family through their highs and lows with love and without offense
- Teach your children to never be offended and never to take offense

ACTION STEPS:

- Prioritize personal devotion and prayer time with your children over church activities
- Model genuine relationship with God at home, not just religious performance
- Teach your children that offense is a choice and train them to forgive quickly
- Give your children the choice and teach them the power of choosing wisely



KEY TEACHING #5

MEASURE BY HOW MANY YOU SEND, NOT GATHER

*"A church should not be measured by how many get in,
but how many are sent."*

The Core Truth:

- Kingdom success is measured by multiplication, not accumulation
- The goal is to equip and release people into their callings
- God is raising up families to take the Word of faith to the uttermost parts of the earth

ACTION STEPS:

- Shift your metrics from attendance to deployment
- Intentionally train and equip people for their unique callings, not just your vision
- Celebrate when people leave to fulfill their calling as much as when they join

➤➤➤ I have the spirit of wisdom to know, beyond a shadow of a doubt, the hope of my calling

➤➤➤ God has invested immense greatness—an inheritance—into me

➤➤➤ I am seated with Christ in heavenly places in a place of authority

➤➤➤ I am far above every principality and power, sickness, disease, lack, and curse

➤➤➤ I am strong in the Lord, strong in the Word, strong in the spirit of faith

➤➤➤ The Word is precious and dear to my heart

➤➤➤ I will know the breadth, depth, and height of God's love

➤➤➤ I am salt in the earth and a bright light that shines far into this dark time
