EPISODE SUMMARY

This is Part 2 of a three-part Deep Dive series walking through Kenneth Copeland's 20-Step Spiritual Action Plan for Faith That Can Move Mountains. Part 1 (EP028) laid the foundation — you have faith, the measure is already in you, and the Word makes it come. Part 2 answers the next question: how do you take that faith and actually put it to work?

*“Today we write some faith checks
and see our faith catch fire.”*

Part 1 established the foundation: you already have faith, the measure is in you, and the Word is what makes it come. Part 2 picks up exactly where that left off and answers the next question — so what do you do with it? How do you take that faith from something sitting in your heart to something actually moving in your life?

Working through Steps 7 through 12, Angel walks through the full activation sequence — the Word as the only source of faith, the heart as a bank account that has to be funded before you can draw on it, the power of spoken words to build or dismantle your life, faith that physically acts as though God has already moved, the love that makes the whole engine run, and the one thing that can shut it all down: unforgiveness.

Whether you've been walking in faith for years or you're just learning to use what God put in you, this episode will show you exactly how faith catches fire.

KEY TAKE AWAYS

- ***The Word of God is the only source of faith — and it must be released.***

There is no shortcut and no substitute. Faith comes by hearing the Word (Romans 10:17). And once it arrives, it must be released — through your words and your actions. Faith that stays inside is faith that stays still.

- ***Your heart is a bank account. No deposit, no return.***

You cannot write faith checks your heart hasn't funded. If you haven't put God's Word about healing into your heart before sickness shows up, words of healing won't come out when you need them. The good news: you can make a Word deposit of any size, any time.

- ***Your words build your life or dismantle it.***

Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks (Matthew 12:34). Whatever is loaded in your heart eventually falls out of your mouth. The tongue is not tamed by willpower — it is tamed by filling the heart with the Word until the Word is what naturally comes out.

- ***Faith acts as though God has already done what He said.***

Once you've prayed about something, the test is simple: do you act like it's done? Do you talk like it's done? Do your feet move like it's done? Faith without corresponding action is dead (James 2:17).

- ***Faith is the wire. Love is the current. Forgiveness keeps the flow.***

Galatians 5:6 says faith works by love — that is not a slogan, it's an engine. And unforgiveness is not a moral failing; it's a tactical disaster. It hands the key to your faith to the person who hurt you. Forgive so your faith can flow.

QUOTES & ENCOURAGEMENTS

“The Word of God produces faith in your heart. There is no other source for it. No other source.”

Key insight: Not your pastor, not worship music, not a podcast. Those things help — but the source is one thing. The moment you treat anything else as the primary source of your faith, the line starts to weaken..

“Your heart is like a bank account. If you want to write faith checks on that account, you must have plenty of Word in there to back them up.”

Key insight: You may not be in a position to make huge deposits into your natural bank account right now — but you can make a Word deposit of any size, any time. And that’s the account that actually matters.

“No man can tame the tongue. Not by willpower, not by trying harder. The tongue is tamed spiritually by filling the heart with the Word until the Word is what comes out.”

Key insight: This takes the pressure off. You are not trying to control what you say through discipline. You are changing what you say by changing what you put in. Fill the heart, and the mouth follows.

“Unforgiveness isn’t a moral failing — it’s a tactical disaster. And it’s handing the key to your faith to the person who hurt you.”

Key Insight: First Corinthians 13:5 (Amplified Classic Edition) says love takes no account of the evil done to it. That’s not weakness — that’s freedom. Forgiveness doesn’t say what they did was okay. It says you refuse to let it short-circuit your faith another day.

KEY SCRIPTURES

Anchoring truths from the heart of this episode.

THIS WEEK'S FAITH STEPS

Five simple, doable moves to put this episode to work in your life.

1. Audit your words.

For one day this week, listen to what comes out of your mouth — about yourself, your health, your finances, your relationships. Write down any words that contradict what God's Word says. Those are the first things the Word you deposit this week will rewrite.

2. Make a Word deposit

Pick one promise from Scripture that directly covers the situation you're standing in faith for. Read it out loud every morning this week before anything else. You are making a deposit.

3. Speak it, don't just think it.

Faith is released through your mouth, not just your mind. Take the verse you chose and say it out loud — with your actual voice — at least once a day. Speak the result you are believing for, not the problem you are looking at.

4. Act like it's done.

After you pray about something this week, take one corresponding action that lines up with your faith. If you're believing for provision, do something generous. If you're believing for healing, do something that someone in full health would do. Faith moves.

5. Forgive and keep the flow open

Name anyone — out loud or in writing — you need to forgive. Say "I forgive you" and mean it the best you can today. Forgiveness is the key that keeps the love flowing so your faith can run.
