# UNDERSTANDING WHAT “GOD IS MY SOURCE” REALLY MEANS TO LIVING IN DIVINE PROVISION

**Core Definition:** “God is my source means that I’m not listening to a person. I’m not looking to a job. I’m purely looking to God as the source for everything that he’s called me to do, whether that’s finances or people or relationships. That he’s the one that provides that.”

**It’s Not Just Financial:** When we say “God is my source,” we’re acknowledging His provision in every area of life:

- Relationships and connections with the right people
- Creative ideas and business strategies
- Opportunities and open doors
- Wisdom and guidance for decisions
- Strength and ability to accomplish tasks
- Financial provision and resources

*“Too many channels, but one source. I use my job, I use people around me, but I keep my eyes on Him as my source.”*



# KEY SCRIPTURE FOUNDATION

*“And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.”*  
— **Deuteronomy 8:18**

**The Power to Get Wealth:** God doesn't just drop money from heaven. He gives us the creative power, ideas, and ability to prosper. This might look like:

- »»» Business ideas and strategies
- »»» Contract structuring wisdom
- »»» Creative solutions to problems
- »»» The right connections at the right time



# SHIFTING YOUR MINDSET: FROM SELF-RELIANCE TO GOD-RELIANCE

**Real-Life Example:** One podcast guest shared how when she was laid off, her first instinct was to immediately start making calls and trying to fix the situation in her own strength. But the Lord told her to stop. When she obeyed and rested in Him instead of striving, the job opportunity came to her.

## Common Mindset Shifts Needed:

**From:** "I need to network with the right people to get ahead"

**To:** "God will connect me with the right people at the right time"

**From:** "I have to work harder than everyone else"

**To:** "God gives me supernatural ability and favor"

**From:** "I need to keep everyone happy to succeed"

**To:** "I live for an audience of One - God sees me and that's enough"

**The Test Question:** When something happens and you need something, where do you look first? This reveals what you truly believe is your source.



# OVERCOMING THE BIGGEST LIES ABOUT GOD'S PROVISION

**Lie #1:** "This happens to other people, but not to me"

**Truth:** God is no respecter of persons. What He can do for one, He can do for another.

**Lie #2:** "I should only believe for my needs, not my dreams"

**Truth:** "There is no dream too big or desire too small that He won't provide." Don't get stuck believing only for needs – God wants to fulfill the desires of your heart too.

*"Delight yourself in the Lord, and He will give you the desires of your heart."*

**— Psalm 37:4**

**Lie #3:** "If I trust God, I shouldn't take any action"

**Truth:** Faith looks like something. It requires obedient action, but it's not striving in your own strength.



# PRACTICAL STEPS TO LIVE THIS TRUTH

## 1. Repent and Realign

Ask the Lord to forgive you for times you've looked to other sources and to show you areas where you're still relying on your own strength instead of Him.

## 2. Renew Your Mind Daily

Focus your faith on specific scriptures about God's provision. Meditate on His promises until they become more real than your circumstances.

## 3. Spend Time Getting to Know His Character

As you delight in the Lord, you'll discover His heart and He'll place His desires in your heart. Ask Him: "What does trusting You look like in my specific situation?"

## 4. Declare God's Word Over Your Life

Speaking God's Word is spiritual warfare. When challenges come, instead of just praying about the problem, declare what God says about your situation.

## 5. Take Progressive Steps of Obedience

God often provides progressively as you take steps of faith. Listen for His instruction and obey, even when it doesn't make logical sense.

## 6. Don't Put Pressure on People

When you truly trust God as your source, you stop manipulating or pressuring people to meet your needs. You live for an audience of One.

## **BASED ON GOD'S WORD**

**“ God is my source for everything I need. He gives me power to get wealth and establishes His covenant in my life. I don't look to people, jobs, or circumstances as my source – I look to Him alone. He meets all my needs according to His riches in glory, and He fulfills the desires of my heart as I delight in Him. There is no dream too big or desire too small that He won't provide. I walk in His supernatural provision and favour, and I live for an audience of One. ”**

# ADDITIONAL SCRIPTURES FOR MEDITATION

➤➤➤ **Matthew 7:7** – “Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you.”

➤➤➤ **Philippians 4:19** – “And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.”

➤➤➤ **Ephesians 3:20** – “Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.”

➤➤➤ **Matthew 6:26** – “Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?”



**Remember:** God's provision often looks different than we expect, but His ways are always higher and better than ours. Trust His timing, trust His methods, and watch Him exceed your expectations.
