# CORE CONCEPT: DIVINE PROVISION

We are invited to see God as our ultimate source—not just for finances, but for every area of our lives.

One testimony shared a powerful moment when God simply said, *“Be a dad. Be a husband.”* That moment redefined what provision meant. It wasn’t about striving—it was about trusting.

When we start seeing our jobs or our own efforts as our source, we limit what God can do. But when we seek Him first, He responds with provision that goes beyond what we could imagine.

## Core Definition

*When we say “God is my source,” we’re declaring that we’re not looking to people or jobs for our needs.*

We’re looking to God for:

- Finances
- Relationships
- Wisdom
- Strength
- Opportunities

He provides everything we need to fulfill His purpose for our lives.



# KEY SCRIPTURE FOUNDATION

*“Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.”*  
— **Matthew 6:33**

## **Shift Our Mindset: From Self-Reliance to God-Reliance**

We may be used to relying on logic, effort, or control. But God invites us to trust Him instead. We include Him in our decisions and let go of the pressure to provide for ourselves. He’s already made a way.



# OVERCOMING THE LIES ABOUT PROVISION

**Lie #1:** "I have to figure it all out myself."

**Truth:** God gives us wisdom when we ask.

**Lie #2:** "Provision only comes through my job."

**Truth:** Our jobs are channels—God is the source.

**Lie #3:** "I can only trust what I can see."

**Truth:** Faith means trusting what God has promised, even when it's not visible.

# PRACTICAL STEPS TO LIVE THIS TRUTH

- 1. Renew Our Minds Daily** – We meditate on God's promises.
- 2. Recognize God's Hand in the Natural** – We see His provision in everyday moments.
- 3. Include God in Every Decision** – We ask Him before acting.
- 4. Let Go of Control** – We trust His timing and methods.



# DECLARATION BASED ON GOD'S WORD

*God is my source. He gives me strength, wisdom, and provision. I do not rely on my job, my efforts, or my understanding. I trust in His abundance, which exceeds anything I could imagine. Even when I don't see the way, I know He is making one. I walk in faith, not fear, and I live in agreement with His Word.*



# DREAMING WITH GOD

- God's abundance is limitless (Ephesians 3:20).
- Our bold prayers and dreams matter.
- Trusting God opens doors for influence and ministry.
- He doesn't just meet needs—He exceeds them.
- Writing down our desires is an act of faith.



# EXPANDING OUR VISION

- Dreaming with God shifts us from survival to purpose.
- We are blessed to be a blessing.
- Generosity unlocks supernatural provision.
- We trust God beyond logic—His plans are bigger than ours.
- His vision breaks cultural molds and expands our calling.





# FAITH IN ACTION

- **Sowing in faith can unlock provision.**
- **Encouragement and prophetic words build our expectation.**
- **God provides in miraculous ways—cars, weddings, finances.**
- **Bold prayers lead to breakthroughs.**
- **He uses unexpected channels—even government backpay!**



# PROVISION, WORK, AND WORSHIP

- God restores what's owed—with interest.
- Provision aligns with obedience and divine timing.
- Work is a gift—we enjoy it.
- Jobs are channels, not sources.
- We avoid job idolatry—we trust God, not our paycheck.
- Provision should glorify God, not luck.
- Trust replaces anxiety—God knows our needs.
- His provision is extravagant (Ephesians 3:20).



# PERSONAL APPLICATION EXERCISES

## Reflection Questions:

- In what areas of our lives are we still trying to be the source?
- Where have we limited God by relying on our own strength?
- How can we invite God into our daily decisions?

## Faith Action Steps:

- Begin each day by declaring God as our source.
- Involve our spouse or accountability partner in prayer.
- Identify one area where we've been striving and surrender it to God.

➤➤➤ **Matthew 6:33** – Seek first the kingdom.

➤➤➤ **Philippians 4:19** – God will supply all your needs.

➤➤➤ **Ephesians 3:20** – God does more than you can ask or imagine.



**Remember:** God's provision often looks different than we expect, but His ways are always higher and better than ours. Trust His timing, trust His methods, and watch Him exceed your expectations.
